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

## **Main structure**



### **The introduction**

Is usually the first part of the essay
 Can be more than one paragraph

#### It's role:

To explain the topic to catch the reader's attention

To focus on the thesis statement

To explain the main steps to follow

Summary Information: a few sentences explaining your topic in general terms

the single, specific claim that the essay supports


the outline (according to the thesis statement)

### The introduction

#### It usually begins with...

<u>General remarks</u> about the topic (requires a background knowledge)

Questions that will be answered in the essay



## Structure of the body of the essay

# Supports the thesis statement

**Examples** 

Details

Facts

Reasons

### Main content of the body of the essay

It contains supporting information for the thesis statement (arguments, details...).

The number of paragraphs will vary according to the thesis statement.

It should have enough support to explain/defend the thesis statement thoroughly and adequately.

### The conclusion

It is the final paragraph that completes the essay.

It may be used to summarize the ideas presented in the essay.

It reminds the reader of the thesis statement.

It should not bring totally new ideas or ideas that are not related to the thesis statement.

It should leave an opening for further research.
